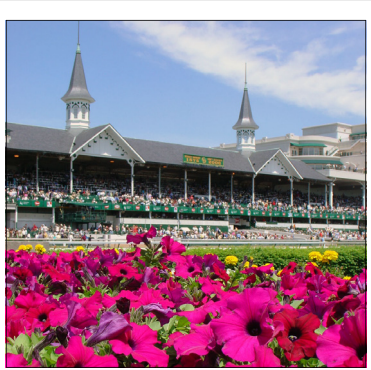

Day #1: Depart St. Louis Southward to Kentucky!

Today we will depart St. Louis on our first-class motorcoach towards Kentucky - The Bluegrass State. We will make stops along the way for breaks and lunch and travel across the beautiful Ohio River into Louisville. We will enjoy a tour of the Louisville Glassworks. This multi-use facility, located in the heart of Downtown Louisville, is dedicated to the art of glass; its magic, its mystery, its beauty. Our tour will take us through the working glass studios, galleries, workshops, and much more! Our accommodation will be nearby and dinner tonight will be served up "Southern Style" . Day #2: Churchill Downs and "My Old Kentucky Home"

This morning we will enjoy a continental breakfast at the hotel before departing for Churchill Downs! Here we will be greeted and enjoy a behind the scenes tour of this famous racetrack - a real treat! We will also visit the Kentucky Derby Museum at Churchill Downs, here you will see many of the historical items and memorabilia from events that took place during "The Greatest Race". We will enjoy some free-time for lunch and shopping prior to departing. This afternoon we will travel to Bardstown, Kentucky. Upon arrival, we will drive through My Old Kentucky Home State Park, one of Kentucky's most historic state parks. The state park consists of Federal Hill, a former plantation owned by the Rowan family. A visit to the site in 1852 inspired Stephen Foster to write his famous song, My Old Kentucky Home. A guided tour will be given of this stately mansion. This evening we will check into our hotel and have a delicious dinner out. [Breakfast / Dinner Included]

Day #3: Bourbon & Cumberland Falls!

We will enjoy our continental breakfast this morning prior to departing for Jim Beam Bourbon Distillery. We will tour the Jim Beam Outpost visitors center and try a nip of Bourbon as well. Then we are off to the southeastern area of the state. This area is known as the Cumberland Valley and home to the second largest waterfall east of the Mississippi - Cumberland Falls and State Park. During this time of year, the fall foliage only enhances the beauty of this already tranquil and peaceful natural wonder. We will tour the state park and enjoy a visit to the falls, museum, visitors center and shop. The falls, which flow over a resistant sandstone bed, are 68 feet high and 125 feet wide, with an average water flow of 3,600 cubic feet per second! We will learn about the famous "moon bow" that occurs here - one of only two places in the entire world. Dinner tonight will be in the beautiful Cumberland Falls Dupont Lodge. Day #4: Homeward Bound and Kentucky Memories.

Our Kentucky departure after breakfast will lead us back west towards Missouri. We will enjoy lunch and breaks, once again, along the way. The Autumn scenery should be great as we journey westward. A great time to reminisce of our fun times and new traveling friends. [Breakfast Included]
