Our first stop will be Tacony Manufacturing in St. James where the "Manufactured in the USA" label is proudly placed on Simplicity and Riccar Vacuum sweepers. After touring the manufacturing facilities we will continue with a guided tour of The Vacuum Cleaner Museum. Over 100 operational sweepers fill the timeline exhibit. Included are a vintage, non-electric 1888 Bissell swivel carpet sweeper that belonged to James Earl Jones and one retired from Air Force One during President George W. Bush's last term in office.

During lunch we will enjoy wonderful Missouri scenery as we dine 400 feet above the Gasconade River at Portugese Point.

After lunch our special guest, Retired SFC Jon Paton, will help us navigate Fort Leonard Wood.

Named after the Civilian to the Secretary of the Army, the Mahaffey Museum Complex houses the rich history and contributions of the Military Police, Army Engineers and Chemical Warfare Units during conflicts dating back to the Revolutionary War. The museum complex is adjacent to the WWII Army Complex museum replicating Fort Leonard Wood as it was during the 1940's.
