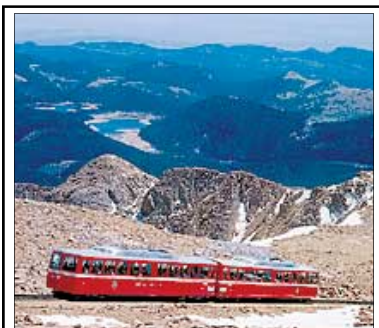
## DAY THREE: PIKE'S PEAK COG RAILWAY
