The **Missouri Botanical Garden** is one of the region's premier cultural attractions. "**Lantern Festival: Art by Day, Magic by Night**" is an international exhibition of 26 larger-than-life, lighted works of art from Zigong, China. The annual lantern festival is one of China's most treasured events and ancient traditions. Elaborate outdoor sets crafted of silk and steel will celebrate Chinese culture through bold color, dazzling light and striking design. The exhibition is the first of its kind and size in the US, offering visitors a unique opportunity to witness a spectacle rarely staged outside of Asia



Lunch will be at **Pappy's Smokehouse**. Pappy's was listed on *The Travel Channel 101 Tastiest Places to Chowdown* and also *Man vs Food Nation*. They prepare delicious, juicy Memphis Style BBQ daily using only the best ingredients. Slow smoking their meats from 4-14 hours over apple or cherry wood and finish them off with a selection of three delicious sauces and a choice of a freshly prepared side. For vegetarians, you will have a non meat selection.

**Third Degree Glass Factory** is a winner of the *St. Louis Magazine A-List*. Molten glass captivates audiences of all ages. During our **Private Demonstration** the ancient process of glassblowing will be professionally explained while artists make at least two glass pieces.



Our day will end with a treat from **Ted Drewes**. The custard itself is world-famous. It comes in several flavors and can be combined with lots of different toppings.
